Class entries – Exhibitors can enter multiple horses into English Riding Control, Western Riding, Reining, and Trail. Each horse/rider combo must have their own assigned number.

Walk-Trot classes are for riders who cannot yet canter/lope. Walk-Trot exhibitors cannot cross-enter into any other age division or classes. Walk-Trot exhibitors may ride with 2 hands on a snaffle bit for any aged horse, or 1 hand with a shank bit.

Novice classes are for individuals with limited riding or showing experience. To enter in Novice, the exhibitor cannot have won champion or reserve champion in a Novice class at any previous ADCO show.

Class awards 1st through 6th place winners can select a ribbon or show bucks.

Gymkhana classes will receive paybacks 1st–5th place (instead of ribbons or show bucks). Payout based on total number of exhibitors in class.

Daily High Point for: Walk-Trot, Novice, 8-10, 11-13, 14-18, 19 & Over.

An open signed check, cash, or credit card form must be on file before numbers will be distributed. Credit Cards will be processed at the end of the day with a 3% service charge added.
