Show is governed by the SHTX Rulebook; cutting is governed by the 4-H Rulebook.

Helmets - All enrolled Adams County 4-H contestants 18 & Under are REQUIRED to wear an ASTM/SEI-approved helmet with a safety harness for all divisions and disciplines. Open and non-4-H members are *strongly encouraged* to wear an ASTM/SEI-approved helmet with safety harness in the Ranch Horse Division.

Attire - All contestants are required to wear proper attire. Please refer to the SHTX Rulebook for tack/attire specifications.

Class entries - Exhibitors can enter multiple horses into the same classes. Each horse/rider combo must be registered and have an assigned number. For division requirements refer to the 2022 SHTX Rulebook.

Awards

Class awards - 1st through 6th place winners can select a ribbon or show bucks. Show bucks provide a monetary value based on class placing and can be redeemed for entries fees for another AdCo show or from Show Me Twice before 12/31/23.

Daily High Point - Winners for AdCo and CoWN will be awarded in each division: Novice Youth, Youth, Novice Adult, Intermediate Non-Pro, Limited Non-Pro, Non-Pro, Junior Horse Non-Pro, Junior Horse Open, Open Novice Horse, and Open.

AdCo Overall Year End Discipline Awards - Points earned from the Ranch Horse shows in the 2023 AdCo show series, based on one horse/rider combo, will count toward the award. Must be a member of AdCo to be eligible.
